



## SIDEWALK ADVOCATES FOR LIFE

### **1-Year Regional Program Coordinator Fellowship**

#### **Overview**

*Sidewalk Advocates for Life (SAFL)* is a 501c3 non-profit organization whose mission is to “train, equip, and support local communities across the United States and the world in sidewalk advocacy: to be the hands and feet of Christ, offering loving, life-affirming alternatives to all present at the abortion center, thereby eliminating demand and ending abortion.”

Because of recent rapid growth and a desire to spread the mission to end abortion through peaceful, prayerful sidewalk advocacy, we are looking for a small group of individuals who would be interested in overseeing the development and growth of a particular region of the United States (and perhaps, internationally) in peaceful sidewalk advocacy (otherwise known traditionally as “sidewalk counseling”).

#### **Timeline**

**The *Regional Program Coordinator Fellowship* runs 1 year from the end of June 2017 – June 2018. Applications will be accepted through Wednesday, May 31, 2017 at 11:59 pm CST.** (Additional contact information below.) Once hired, each fellow will be assigned a particular region of the United States or world.

Early in the fellowship year, SAFL will provide staff training in the Dallas, TX area with travel, food, and hotel covered.

This summer, each fellow will be required to professionally raise support to cover their fellowship with SAFL. Instructions and professional training will be provided at the end of June.

Each Regional Program Coordinator will be required to report to their region (or be ready to serve their region) at the end of August to begin the heart of their fellowship year. The fellowship will be completed at the end of June 2018, at which time, a fellow may be invited back.

#### **Job Responsibilities**

- Serving current SAFL locations in your region; this includes – but is not limited to – supporting Program Directors and teams of Sidewalk Advocates, conducting trainings, and periodically, sidewalk counseling alongside them
- Representing SAFL at pro-life, pro-family national or regional conferences and events
- Assisting national staff in developing resources or tools relevant to your region
- Actively recruiting new SAFL locations in your region
- Researching abortion facilities in your region and documenting level of activity on the sidewalk

## **Key Qualifications**

- College degree or equivalent job experience
- Experience serving others outside of abortion facilities (through prayer and / or peaceful outreach)
- Enthusiasm for training and helping others
- Public speaking experience
- Desire to help mothers and families in a crisis / unplanned pregnancy
- Willingness to travel regularly (about 1-2 times per month)
- Ascribes to the Christian faith and willing to work with other Christians, cross-denominationally
- Peaceful, prayerful, and law-abiding

## **Compensation**

Each Regional Program Coordinator will be asked to create a budget for his / her estimated, yearly financial need. A Regional Program Coordinator's budget may not exceed a \$35,000 / year salary. Each Regional Coordinator will receive professional support-raising training in order to best reach their yearly needs.

## **Training Program**

Early in the fellowship, Regional Program Coordinators will attend staff training in the Dallas, TX. Additionally, SAFL will provide professional support-raising training at the end of June. Inability to attend training for non-serious reasons may disqualify a Regional Program Coordinator from being part of the fellowship that year.
